Floating Platform Underwater Inspection in Lieu of Drydock (UWILD)

Atlantas Marine was contracted to deliver a full UWILD (Underwater Inspection in Lieu of Drydock) for a floating production unit located on the UK Continental Shelf. With the vessel's class certification approaching renewal, a thorough underwater inspection was required—without disrupting ongoing operations.

Atlantas Marine mobilised quickly, transporting ROV systems offshore via support vessel. Under the supervision of a classification society surveyor, our team deployed a Defender-class ROV to carry out a full inspection of the vessel's subsea infrastructure.

Key areas assessed included hull welds, mooring chains and fairleads, sea chests, hull penetrations, and anodes. Marine growth was removed where necessary, and detailed measurements were taken to assess wear and structural condition—even in low-visibility environments. High-definition footage and precise data were compiled into a comprehensive report, allowing the vessel to be re-certified without delay. By avoiding drydock, the operator reduced both cost and downtime.

This project highlights Atlantas Marine's ability to deliver efficient, safe and high-quality UWILD inspections in challenging offshore conditions.



Remote Explosive Ordnance Disposal Equipment Testing

Atlantas Marine supported a recent live deployment of the Tornado Subsea Initiation System during EOD operations across various in-land and offshore testing facilities. Designed to reduce risk to life, the system enables safe, remote initiation of electrical detonators and disruptors via an ROV, removing the need for diver-based fitting.

Mounted to a VideoRay Defender ROV, the Tornado allowed precise activation of over 120 disruptor firings during trial conditions. Its dual high-voltage ports and auxiliary switching provided full control and reliability, even under recoil stress.

Controlled from the surface via tether, the system operated at depth with no performance loss. Data from the trials confirmed full mission success with zero human exposure to the target area. With support from Atlantas Marine's structured pilot training pathway, operators gained the skills needed to conduct remote EOD, search and clearance missions around maritime infrastructure.

The Tornado system offers a proven, safe solution for high-risk subsea operations—supporting defence and commercial teams with confidence.



Quarry Clearance Operation

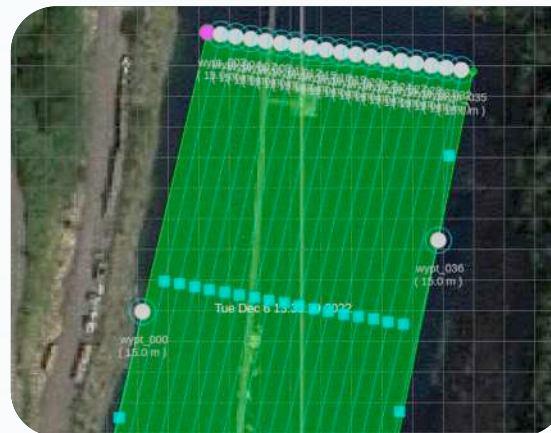


Atlantas Marine was appointed to deliver a full underwater clearance operation at a disused quarry site, following its planned conversion into a controlled water body for future infrastructure development. The site presented a number of operational challenges, including reduced visibility, uneven terrain, and submerged industrial debris left from historical quarrying activity.

An observation-class ROV was mobilised to conduct an initial survey, identifying large sections of redundant pipework, steel cabling, and sediment-covered machinery. Following this, a phased clearance programme was implemented using diver support and hydraulic recovery equipment to safely extract and relocate obstructions.

Over the course of the project, more than 7 tonnes of submerged material were recovered, including several large-scale structures exceeding 3 metres in length. Detailed logs, imagery, and positional data were recorded for all recovered assets to ensure full traceability and environmental accountability.

The successful completion of the clearance enabled the client to move forward with site re-purposing, confident in the safety, stability, and accessibility of the underwater environment. The work was delivered on time, within budget, and in full compliance with local environmental regulations.



Subsea Inspection of Offshore Wind Farm Structures

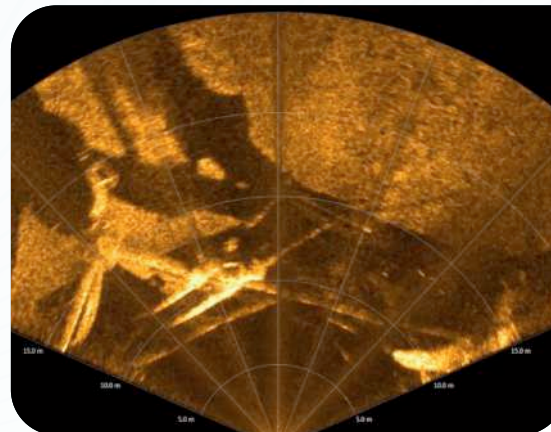

Atlantas Marine was contracted to perform a full subsea inspection campaign across a live offshore wind farm to assess the condition of turbine foundations and associated infrastructure. The project aimed to provide asset integrity data, confirm compliance with industry standards, and identify potential maintenance needs ahead of scheduled upgrades.

Working from a dynamically positioned support vessel, our offshore team deployed a work-class ROV system equipped with high-definition video, CP probes, and ultrasonic thickness (UT) tools. The inspection included monopile and transition piece structures, J-tubes, anode condition assessments, and scour surveys across 40 turbine locations. Operations were carried out over a two-week window in challenging tidal conditions. Each turbine structure was systematically documented, with key findings—including coating degradation, marine growth coverage, and minor structural anomalies—logged against GIS-referenced positions. Data was processed into a detailed digital inspection report with full video records and maintenance recommendations.

The campaign provided the client with a clear, evidence-based understanding of asset health, supporting both short-term planning and long-term operational resilience. The project was completed ahead of schedule and with no reported incidents.



Cable Protection System (CPS) Inspection

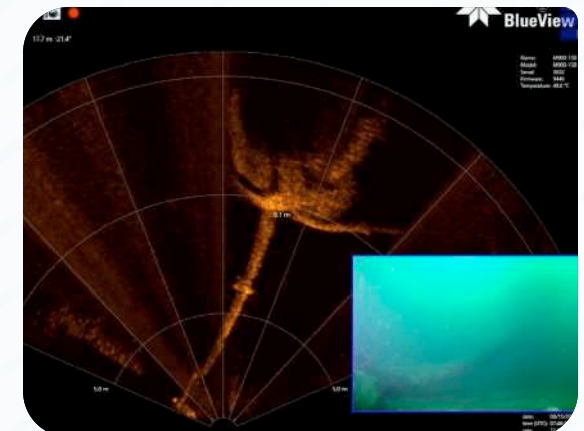

Atlantas Marine was commissioned to inspect and assess the condition of a series of cable protection systems (CPS) installed across multiple offshore wind turbine generator foundations. These systems are critical in safeguarding high-voltage subsea cables from damage caused by hydrodynamic forces, seabed movement, and mechanical impact during operation.

Our team mobilised from a DP2-class support vessel and deployed inspection-class ROVs fitted with ultra-high-definition cameras, scaling lasers, and cathodic protection measurement tools. The scope included visual inspection of CPS entry points at the J-tube interface, midline exposure, and seabed touchdown zones across 36 turbine locations. Several instances of CPS displacement, external abrasion, and partial burial were recorded—particularly in areas with mobile sediment and strong tidal activity. All findings were logged in a structured reporting format with annotated imagery, measurement overlays, and GPS-referenced positional data.

The survey enabled the client to prioritise remedial works, reduce the risk of cable failure, and extend the operational life of their infrastructure. The project was completed safely, with zero downtime and full client satisfaction.



Subsea Freespan Pipeline Inspection

Atlantas Marine was engaged to undertake a full freespan inspection of a major subsea pipeline system located within an active offshore wind development zone. Freespans occur when sections of pipe are unsupported by the seabed, often due to seabed erosion or shifting sediment, which can lead to excessive stress, vibration, and ultimately, fatigue-related failure.

Deploying a work-class ROV equipped with high-definition cameras and multi-beam sonar, our offshore team surveyed over 10km of subsea pipeline. The operation was conducted from a dynamically positioned vessel over a five-day window, with live data streamed topside for real-time review.

Several freespans exceeding design tolerances were identified, including one critical section over 4.5m in length. Each span was documented and geo-referenced, with findings compiled into a detailed inspection report and digital twin overlay to assist with planning corrective action.

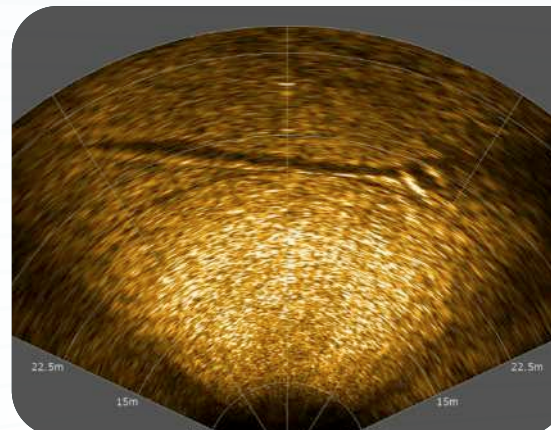
The inspection enabled the client to take immediate steps to mitigate long-term risk and ensure compliance with regulatory and operational standards. The project was delivered safely, on time, and within budget.
